Clause 4. Commencement and Term of Agreement

Amend to delete and insert:

- a) This Agreement operates from seven days after the FWC approves the Agreement in accordance with the FW Act.
- b) The nominal expiry date of this Agreement is 30 June 2024 2026. The Agreement will continue to operate after its nominal expiry date until it is replaced or terminated in accordance with the FW Act.

Clause 9. Remuneration Clause 9.1 Rates of Pay Amend to insert:

9.1 Rates of Pay

- a) The wage rates are in in Attachment 2 of this Agreement.
- b) The hourly rates in Attachment 2 of this Agreement include the following wage increases, which will be paid effective from the full first pay period on or after the dates provided:

c) The Company may pay to an Employee a higher rate than that provided for in Attachment 2, in recognition of an Employee's exceptional performance, or the Company's success, or take into account labour market demands. Any additional payment is at the sole discretion of the Company and must be approved in writing by the relevant General Manager. Where an employee is paid a wage rate higher than that provided for in Attachment 2, the wage increases in clause 9.1(b) above will apply to their higher rate.

For clarity, existing employees whose base rate of pay is higher than the minimum rates for their classification as contained in the table below, will continue to be paid their higher rate of pay, and the wage increases provided for in this Agreement will be applied to their higher rate.

The above wage rates effective from 01 July 2024 include a 4% wage increase that is effective that is applicable to employees who remain employed by the Company at the time the Agreement becomes operational.
