Expense-related allowances.

A. Pursuant to s 157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth), the above award is varied as follows:

1. By deleting the amount "\$28.98" appearing in clause 15.2(a)(i) and inserting "\$30.01".

2. By deleting the amount "\$6.83" appearing in clause 15.2(a)(ii) and inserting "\$7.07".

3. By deleting the amount "\$13.70" appearing in clause 15.2(c)(i) and inserting "\$14.60".

4. By deleting the amount "\$16.72" appearing in clause 15.2(c)(ii) and inserting "\$17.82".

5. By deleting the table appearing in clause B.1.1 and inserting the following:

Allowance	Clause	\$	Payable
Racecourse attendance allowance— within 75km of place of employment	15.2(a)(i)	30.01	per attendance
Racecourse attendance allowance— more than 75km of place of employment—additional to clause 15.2(a)(i)	15.2(a)(ii)	7.07	per each additional 50km or part thereof

Allowance	Clause	\$	Payable
Meal allowance—attendance at a race meeting	15.2(c)(i)	14.60	per meal
Meal allowance—overtime—more than one and a half hours without notification	15.2(c)(ii)	17.82	per meal
Boots, caps and vest allowance— track riders	15.2(f)	5.46	per week

B. This determination comes into operation on 1 July 2024. In accordance with s 165(3) of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth) this determination does not take effect in relation to a particular employee until the start of the employee's first full pay period that starts on or after 1 July 2024.
