Expense-related allowances.

A. Pursuant to s 157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth), the above award is varied as follows:

1. By deleting the amount “\$0.95” appearing in clause 23.2(a) and inserting “\$0.98”.
2. By deleting the amount “\$16.81” appearing in clause 23.3(a) and inserting “\$17.92”.
3. By deleting the amounts “5.63” and “4.34” appearing in clause 23.4(a) and inserting “5.76” and “4.44” respectively.
4. By deleting the amount “\$17.14” appearing in clause 23.4(b)(i) and inserting “\$17.53”.
5. By deleting the amount “\$848.93” appearing in clause 23.4(b)(ii) and inserting “\$868.30”.
6. By deleting the amounts “\$30.37” and “\$212.62” appearing in clause 23.5 and inserting “\$31.45” and “\$220.16” respectively.

7. By deleting the table appearing in clause E.2.1 and inserting the following:

B. This determination comes into operation on 1 July 2024. In accordance with s 165(3) of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth) this determination does not take effect in relation to a particular employee until the start of the employee's first full pay period that starts on or after 1 July 2024.
