Expense-related allowances.

A. Pursuant to s 157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth), the above award is varied as follows:

1. By deleting the amount “\$13.37” appearing in clause 18.3(b) and inserting “\$14.25”.
2. By deleting the amounts “15.48” and “30.19” appearing in clause 18.3(d)(i) and inserting “15.83” and “30.88” respectively.
3. By deleting the amount “\$0.95” appearing in clause 18.3(f) and inserting “\$0.98”.
4. By deleting the table appearing in clause D.2.1 and inserting the following:

Meal allowance—overtime of 2 or more hours	18.3(b)	14.25	per occasion
Tool allowance—Tradesperson (other than Carpenters)	18.3(d)(i)	15.83	per week
Tool allowance—Carpenters	18.3(d)(i)	30.88	per week

Uniform allowance—laundrying—per day	18.3(e)(iii)	1.32	per day
Uniform allowance—laundrying maximum per week—up to	18.3(e)(iii)	6.62	per week
Vehicle allowance—use of own vehicle	18.3(f)	0.98	per km

B. This determination comes into operation on 1 July 2024. In accordance with s 165(3) of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth) this determination does not take effect in relation to a particular employee until the start of the employee’s first full pay period that starts on or after 1 July 2024.
