The Fair Work Commission's functions under s.576 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (FW Act) include providing advice and assistance about its functions and activities. The Commission is conducting research related to its functions in order to better understand how we can assist users of our website through enhanced website architecture, information resources and services. If you are eligible to participate and with your written consent, the Commission will disclose your personal information to our external research supplier, Icon Agency, for the purpose of contacting you to participate in an online workshop or telephone interview.

Your personal information will not be used for any other purpose or disclosed to any other person or organisation by the Commission or Icon Agency unless such use or disclosure is with your consent or is otherwise permitted under the *Privacy Act 1988* (Cth).
