

Information note— Gender undervaluation: ACTU data request - Part 1

28 October 2024

The data presented in this information note responds to a request from the Australian Council of Trade Unions (ACTU) that the Fair Work Commission conduct and publish research for the *Gender undervaluation – priority awards review.*¹ In particular, it responds to items 1, 2, 3 and 7 of the request by providing data from the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) Census of Population and Housing (Census).² Not all of the items requested could be accommodated, with some data for item 2 not available and some data for item 7 not available in the Census. Remaining items will be addressed in a separate information note using the ABS Survey of Employee Earnings and Hours 2023 where possible.

Table 1 shows the number of employees who are estimated to be covered by the 3 modern awards in the request for 2011 and 2021. Tables 2 and 3 present characteristics based on data for 2021. The employees covered have been determined based on their occupation, defined by the Australian and New Zealand Standard Classification of Occupations (ANZSCO), while working within the relevant industries, defined by Australian and New Zealand Standard Industrial Classification (ANZSIC). Appendix A lists the industries and occupations considered to represent coverage for each modern award.

Data for employees covered by the *Health Professionals and Support Services Award 2020* are divided by occupations, with the final group combining health professionals from Schedule B of the award.
