Dear Chambers

We refer to the above-mentioned matter concerning the consultation on Tuesday, 19 March 2024 regarding the *Hospitality Industry (General) Award* and the *Restaurant Industry Award* (collectively, the **Awards**).

During the consultation, the AHA was tasked with correlating an appropriate level of training to each of the grades in the Awards. Part of this process also involved liaising with the United Workers Union (**UWU**) to receive further input.

By way of update, on 15 April 2024 the AHA sent UWU a draft proposal of the applicable level of training for each grade in the *Hospitality Industry (General) Award* for its review and consideration. We can confirm these discussions are progressing well.

We will continue to have discussions with UWU over the coming weeks in terms of further feedback and suggestions regarding our proposal and expect to have formal supplementary submissions to Chambers following shortly after.
