We refer to the consultation process for the Modern Awards Review in respect of Job Security and Work and Care (**Awards Review**).

In particular, we refer to submissions and material filed by the Flight Attendants' Association of Australia (**FAAA**) in respect of the Awards Review concerning the *Aircraft Cabin Crew Award 2020* (**ACCA**).

The Qantas Group does not consent to the variations proposed by the FAAA to the ACCA.

It is our understanding that while industry specific matters may be raised by stakeholders as part of the consultation process, the Commission will not be considering variations to awards such as the ACCA at this stage of the Awards Review.
