This morning the Full Bench asked whether the Association of Independent Schools (AIS) had been served a copy of the Union's application to vary the *Educational Services (Teachers) Award 2010* dated 17 August 2018.

Based on his instructions, Mr Taylor indicated that the AIS had been served. Due to a misunderstanding those instructions were in fact not correct. The only parties that have been served to date are the ACA/ABL, AFEI, CCER and the Commonwealth. The IEU is taking immediate steps to notify the various state-based organisations representing independent schools as well as the Victorian, Northern Territory and ACT Governments.
