Review of classification rates at the C14 and C13 level in modern awards – Travelling Shows Award 2020 – award varied.

- A. Further to the decision issued by the Expert Panel on 19 November 2024 [[2024] FWCFB 438], the above award is varied as follows:
- 1. By deleting the first paragraph in clause 12.2 and inserting the following:

An employee at this level is a new entrant to the travelling shows industry and is employed as a ride attendant and includes employees not otherwise classified. An employee at this level:

- 2. By renumbering clauses 12.2(a) to (i) as clauses 12.2(b) to (j).
- 3. By inserting a new clause 12.2(a) as follows:
 - (a) has less than 3 months' experience in the travelling shows industry;
- 4. By renumbering clauses 12.3(a) to (k) as clauses 12.3(b) to (l).
- 5. By inserting a new clause 12.3(a) as follows:
 - (a) has at least 3 months' experience in the travelling shows industry;

- 6. By updating the cross-references accordingly.
- B. This determination comes into operation on 1 January 2025. In accordance with s 165(3) of the *Fair Work Act 2009* this determination does not take effect in relation to a particular employee until the start of the employee's first full pay period that starts on or after 1 January 2025.
