- A. Pursuant to s.157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009*, the above award is varied as follows:
1. By deleting the amount “\$16.33” appearing in clause 18.3(a)(i) and inserting “\$16.71”.
  2. By deleting the amount “\$89.33” appearing in clause 18.3(b)(i) and inserting “\$93.42”.
  3. By deleting the amount “\$624.96” appearing in clause 18.3(b)(ii) and inserting “\$653.57”.
  4. By deleting the table appearing in clause C.2.1 and inserting the following:
