- A. Further to the decision issued by the Expert Panel in the Annual Wage Review 2023–24 on 3 June 2024 [[2024] FWCFB 3500], the above award is varied as follows:
- 1. By deleting the table appearing in clause 8.4 and inserting the following

- 2. By deleting the amount "\$4.92" appearing in clause 9.8(a) and inserting "\$5.10".
- 3. By deleting the amount "\$3.46" appearing in clause 9.8(b) and inserting "\$3.59".
- 4. By deleting the amount "\$0.78" appearing in clause 9.8(c) and inserting "\$0.81".

5. By deleting the table appearing in clause B.1 and inserting the following:

Language skills allowance - Grade 2	per hour	18.45	5.10
Language skills allowance - Grade 3	per hour	12.3	3.59
Language skills allowance - Grade 4	per hour	2.53	0.81
